The Lenten Season is just around the corner. With Christmas behind us, we look ahead as a school community to the beginning of Lent at the end of this month. We have the CISVA Catholic Educators' Conference February 9 and 10 combined to make an extended long weekend with a staff retreat the day before, February 8, and BC Family Day, February 13.

8:45 - 9:30 - Kindergarten (Siy) and Grade 7


9:30-10:15 - Grade 3 and Grade 5

THE PRESENTATION OF JESUS AT THE TEMPLE



On February 2, the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas day. The Feast of the Presentation commemorates when Mary and Joseph took Jesus to Jerusalem because every firstborn child was to be dedicated to the Lord. Once in the temple, Jesus was purified by the prayer of Simeon, in the presence of Anna the prophetess. Simeon, upon seeing the Messiah, gave thanks to the Lord, singing a hymn now called the *Nunc Dimittis*:

*Lord, now you let your servant go in peace,
your word has been fulfilled:
My own eyes have seen the salvation,
which you have prepared in the sight of every people:
a light to reveal you to the nations
and the glory of your people Israel.*
